Having known my condition I decided to donate this fund to a mosque, or an Islamic organisation or better still a Moslem that will utilize this funds the way I am going to instruct here in. My main aim of doing this is for the propagation and upholding of the message of Prophet Muhammad(peace be upon Him).I want this funds to be used for Zakah and for helping the poor after the Ramadan fasting and performing pilgrimage. Also In the western world, you find out that the message of Allah has not yet really gotten there.

My apologies for suggesting the use of a third party charity. I realized afterwards that this institution was not Islamic and therefore not exactly what you were looking for. I am not sure if it has been made clear to you or not, but I must confess that I am not a

Muslim myself. The fact is, I am something of a humanistic agnostic with a shade of Mahayana Buddhist thrown in for good measure.

I have not been to Abidjan for some time and am still uncertain as to who gave you my information. I would like to be of help, but again, the only worthwhile charitable institution I know in the region is the Barnabus Fund. I would hope that you would reconsider contacting them. Although they are a secular institution, they do help many Muslims in need.

Lastly, I am not 100% certain what you are speaking of when you mention what bank the money is deposited in. I have scanned the previous emails looking for information as to what bank you are keeping that money, but I can't find it. I hope you have not lost your receipts, although if you have I am certain you must be on good enough terms with officials at the bank to explain the situation adequately. In my experience, depositing millions of dollars (or pounds for that matter) in a bank earns you a fair amount of trust with the upper level staff. Be sure to use this to your advantage.

Last night I had a friend over for dinner. His name is Ted Mitchell, and he works for a bank in the United States d.b.a. Bank of America. I asked him about setting up bank accounts in the states and he advised me that under such circumstances investors are required by law to produce both a proper ID and a social security number. Don't worry, I didn't mention you by name. I made it seem as though I was asking him this information solely for my own interest. In fact, I even told him that I was considering becoming a banker myself and that these questions were

part of the necessary foundations needed to work in that industry. I do hope he does not set me up with applications and interviews with his staff at the bank, as I am far too old to be working there. I have enough trouble keeping track of my own holdings, the last thing I should be doing is taking charge of other people's accounts. When I was younger I was quite the maverick. Today all of the numbers seem to swim on the paper and confuse me. I should hire a money manager of some sort, but I can't be bothered. I am growing older and my time is short.

Supposing I were to be finished off in some way shape or form en route to an interview with a prospective secretary, or worse yet, during such an interview?

Such an event, horrible to even consider, would most likely arouse within the money manager the idea of 'this is not my problem,' and if my dealings in the past with these men are any indication, they would be more likely to call in a secretary or office girl, someone they deem more compassionate, but who, in the long run, is unsuited for the travails of an old man's death throes, however valiant or gracefully that old man might come to term.

But, I digress. As to my phone number, I daren't tell you. The

rates from the Ivory Coast to America are prohibitive, even for the shortest of conversations. I would feel incredibly guilty if you were to call and I was unable to comprehend the nuances of your needs in quick order. It takes time at my age. I read over the same emails again and again to import their meanings. Or, supposing we found out through discussion, that you and I knew some of the same people, or had a similar interest in the flying of kites (I very much love kiting), such topics lead to delightful conversations, but delightful conversations take time to truly enjoy, and it would be a tragedy if you wasted your zakat speaking to me long distance, regardless of how delightful that conversation might be. Anyhow, here is some news that might just thrill you. I found a bank that specializes in overseas accounts that you can access over the internet to set up an account! Dear Falex,

I am very sorry about my lack of correspondence lately but I have  
been  
very busy travelling to remote areas that do not have adequate  
infrastructure for internet access. All of this was done in the

interest of avenging the death of my beloved Princeps who died at the hands of a KGB operative who it turns out was named Stanislav Goetse.

I had to pay a great deal to get this information from an ex-CIA official who I can only discuss as Mr. M.

My friend Falex, I have spoken at length with Mr. M about a possible business venture which would be able to finance the operation through

secret holdings which would keep the money hidden from the Russia's
